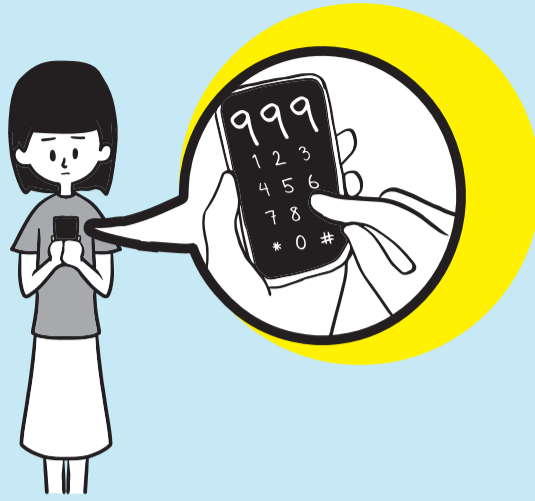

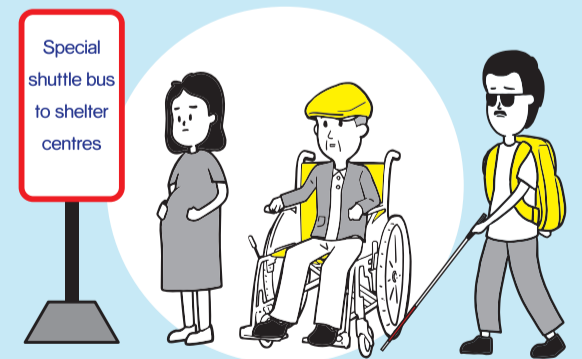

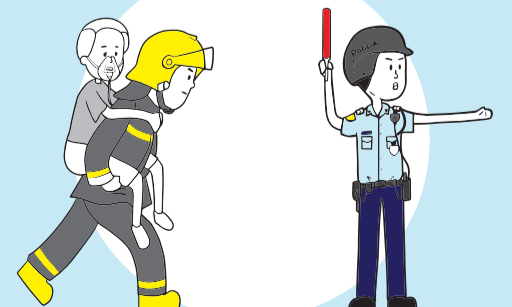
- Homes of relatives and friends

- Shelter centre



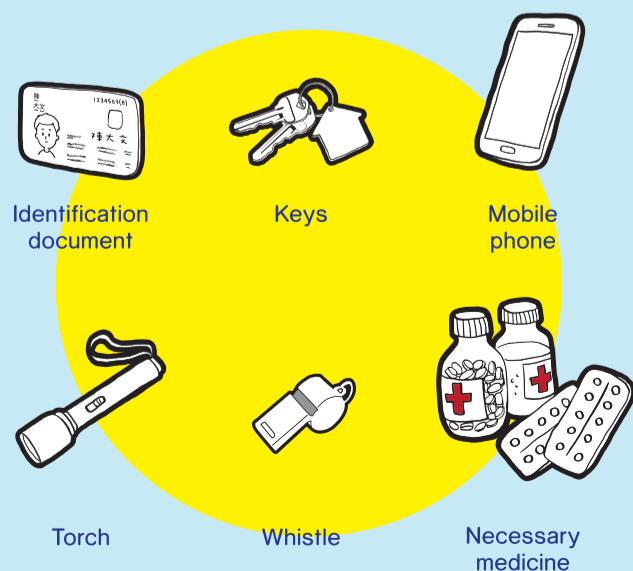
Persons in need may take the available transportation at the designated assembly points to the shelter centres



Please follow the police instructions and evacuate in order

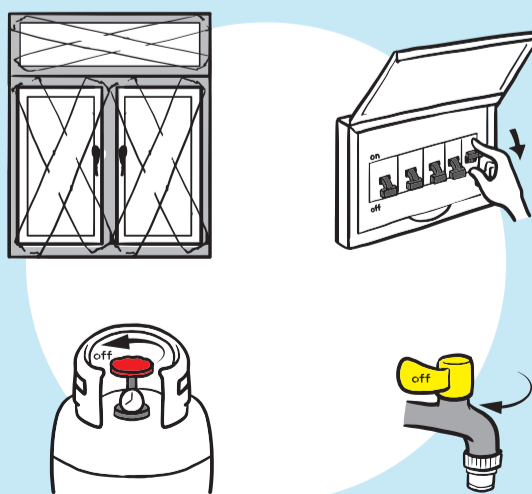

Close the doors and windows; disconnect electric and water supply

Evacuate safely and in order

When time is sufficient, evacuate to a safe place (homes of relatives, friends, neighbours and shelter centre) according to the plan in advance.



Evacuate safely and promptly

When time is insufficient, evacuation is carried out promptly.



Emergency escape and evacuation

When time is limited, emergency evacuation is carried out to safeguard lives (escape to high ground or emergency evacuation staying point).



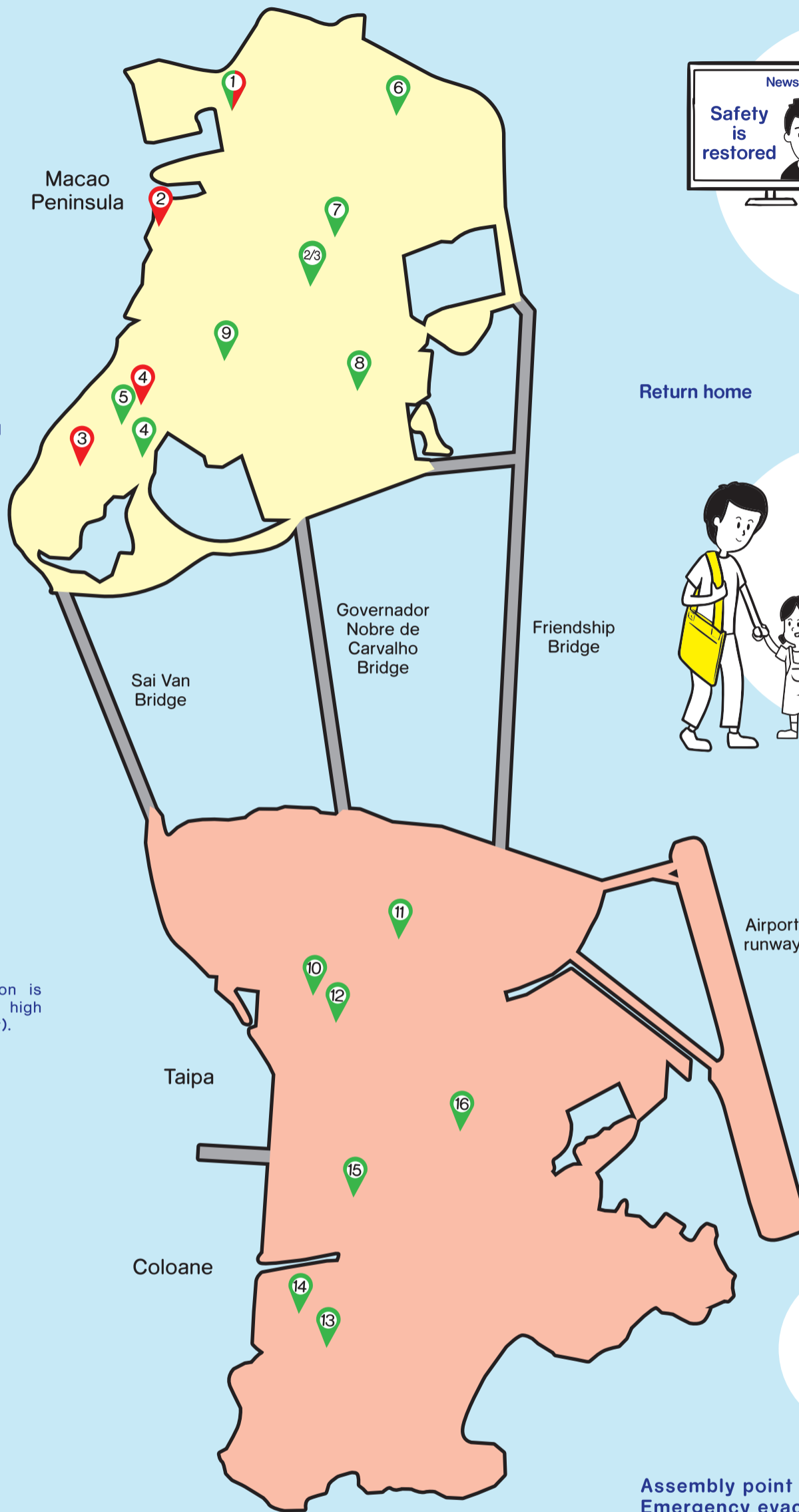
