



CESL Asia and Friends Sport Fun Day 2019

Venue: Macau Federation of Trade Unions Workers Stadium

Major Activity: Football Tournament & Bocce Tournament

Objectives:

- Aims to join hands with like-minded parties with a common interest in promoting social integration at all levels and stimulating public's care for the underprivileged groups through investment in education, training and work opportunities.
- To support the development of sport opportunities for the disabled as well as to build up a healthy lifestyle in our society.
- All the funds raised will be donated to the Macau Special Olympics (MSO), enabling it to strengthen its mission of transforming lives through sports.

Participation & Support

- For entities interested in joining us, you may consider one or more of the below options:
 1. Participation
 - Form a bocce team of 2-3 pax to participate in the Bocce Tournament
 2. Sponsorship in money
 - Cash donation to the Macau Special Olympics
 3. Sponsorship in kind
 - Sponsor items needed in the event, like F & B, external communication service, etc.

Guideline – Bocce Ball

1. Participation

Each participating company or organization forms a team of 2-3 members and teams up with 1-2 Macau Special Olympics (MSO) athletes to become a 4-person team to participate in the bocce tournament. Each participating team should wear its own team clothing and use its company/organization name as its team name.



2. Forms of Competition (Team Race)

2.1 Round-robin competition: Teams are divided into groups by draws. Each team will compete with one another within the group, and the top four teams with higher scores will proceed to the knock-out phase of the competition.

2.2 Knock-out phase: The four teams will compete with one another, and winners will go to the tournament final while losing sides will play against each other to determine the tournament second runner-up and third runner-up.

3. Rankings & Awards

3.1 Rankings will be decided by the number of scores obtained from the round-robin competition and/or knock-out competition.

3.2 The four winning teams will be awarded champion, runner-up, second runner and third runner-up trophy respectively.

4. Training Session

Prior to the event, training sessions will be scheduled to instruct all the participating teams how to play, score and compete in the bocce tournament and its rules.

5. Insurance

The organizer has purchased the basic insurance for the activity whereas each team is responsible for its own team's injuries and insurance liabilities.

6. Donation

For each entity present on that day, CESL Asia will donate MOP \$2,000 to the event while all funds raised from participants will be donated to MSO directly. Dummy cheque with company name and logo will be presented as a special recognition for the participants who donate MOP 6,000 or above at the Charity Cheque Ceremony.
