| <p>預防新型冠狀病毒肺炎 - 對乘搭港珠澳大橋穿梭巴士 (金巴) 由香港入境本澳的乘客指引 Prevent Novel Coronavirus Pneumonia - Guidelines on Passengers of Hong Kong-Zhuhai-Macao Bridge Shuttle Buses (Golden Buses) Travelling to Macao from Hong Kong</p> | | |

In response to the latest development of the COVID-19 situation, in accordance with the stipulations of paragraph 2, article 4 of Decree-Law no. 81/99/M and item 2), paragraph 2, article 10 of Law no. 2/2004 – “Law on the Prevention, Control and Treatment of Infectious Diseases”, starting from 12:00 of 13th July 2020, all passengers of Hong Kong-Zhuhai-Macao Bridge shuttle buses (golden buses) travelling to Macao from Hong Kong are required to present a certificate of negative result for COVID-19 nucleic acid test, in order to safeguard the health of the bus crew members and other passengers.

I. Applicable targets

All passengers of Hong Kong-Zhuhai-Macao Bridge shuttle buses (golden buses) travelling to Macao from Hong Kong

II. Notes to passengers

1. Passengers are required to hold a nucleic acid test certificate with negative result issued by a qualified medical institution in the place of origin; the certificate is valid for a period of 7 days.
2. The aforementioned valid certificate should be presented to the staff upon purchase of the bus ticket and/or boarding.

III. Notes to bus operators

1. Bus operators should request passengers to present a nucleic acid test certificate with negative result issued by a qualified medical institution in the place of origin; the certificate is valid for a period of 7 days.
2. Persons who fail to present a valid nucleic acid test certificate should not be allowed to board.
