

TOEFL Preparation Course

Objective: The course is designed to prepare students for the **TOEFL iBT**. Students will practice

test-taking skills with supplementary exercises in reading, listening, speaking, and

writing.

Target: Undergraduates and postgraduates who intend to pursue graduate study abroad,

in which TOEFL score is one of the admission requirements.
