

Macao Foundation Outgoing Exchange Scholarship Guideline

ELIGIBILITY& SELECTION CRITERIA

- 1. Applicants must be <u>Macau local students</u> who participate in a regular credit-bearing exchange programme at undergraduate or postgraduate level offered by the University of Macau.
- 2. Duration of exchange should be from one semester to one academic year.
- 3. Applicants are selected according to their academic standing, the minimum cumulative GPA for undergraduate applicants for applying the Scholarship is at least 3.0 (FLL students: 14/20).
- 4. In order to receive the full scholarship, undergraduate applicant is required to achieve at least two-thirds of the full time credit equivalence in Host University. For postgraduate applicant, academic performance during the exchange period will be evaluated by the faculty and approved by the Committee.
- 5. Successful applicant can only apply for this Scholarship <u>ONCE</u> in each academic year and is <u>NOT ALLOWDED</u> to receive double subsidy at the same time for the same exchange programme from UM and/or other entities.

AMOUNT OF SCHOLARSHIP

The amount of Scholarship (one semester) will vary according to destination countries or regions as per the table shown below:

Destination Countries / Regions	Amount of Scholarship (One Semester)
Zone 1 Americas (South, North and Central) and Europe	MOP \$ 20,000
Zone 2 Oceania (Australia and New Zealand) and Africa	MOP \$ 17,000
Zone 3 Japan and South Korea	MOP \$ 12,000
Zone 4 Asia (except for Japan and South Korea)	MOP \$ 10,000

*Successful applicant who has an exchange period of 1 year will receive <u>TWO</u> semesters scholarship.

SCHOLARSHIP ARRANGEMENT

Applications will be passed to Macao Foundation for further handling after presenting the following official original receipts:

- Offer Letter issued by the Host University
- Letter of Undertaking

Obligation of Scholarship Recipients

Scholarship recipients have to attend the "Exchange Students Sharing and Information Section" after the exchange and share their experience or assist interested students who are going to join the same exchange programmes as the recipients. Students who have queries on pre-departure preparation can contact scholarship recipients through the contact provided.

APPLICATION

Applications will be invited twice a year. Apply it via https://isw.umac.mo/oesas.

Supplementary documents such as Macao ID card and Student ID card are required.

Applicants are suggested to access the online application system by using **Firefox and IE Browser**. Successful applicants will receive a notification email after you have completed your online application. **Late or incomplete applications will not be considered.**

The OES Secretariat will consolidate all online applications after the deadline of application. The applications will be sent to faculties for verification of the applicant's eligibility. Eligible applications will be reviewed in the OES Committee Meeting. Members of the OES Committee will assess the applicants according to the criteria (as listed in "Selection Criteria").
